

In this class, we will explore the "translation in Glass" of an Italian river forest landscape image in fall season. The need to mix Sulfur color glasses (red, yellow and orange) with Cooper greens and Lead pinks to obtain the fall season scenery in a process with so many successive firings represents a very serious challenge. Reactivity effects and possible changes in the physical structure of the glass require a high level of attention and an accurate study of the "architecture" of the image through each firing, in a near two inches thick final piece.

CLASS SIZE: 4 to 6 students.

GOALS:

Acquire the ability to manage technical issues. Discover the potential of overlaying colors layer upon layer to catch the magic autumn atmosphere without risking the glass' sufferance. Get a deeper perception about Glass behavior and improve the quality of the transmission of light through the increasing of thickness in our pieces. Manage perfect kiln firing schedules to get a piece in "perfect shape and health". Improve our hand coldworking skills. Give the final setting of the piece major value in order to upraise the poetry of the piece.

CLASS PLAN:

10 days class. 8 lessons in studio. Fifth day off for sightseeing in the area. Ninth day off (possible tour to Portofino).


